1&2	Step fwd on L, Lock R behind L, Step fwd on L
3&4	Step fwd on R, Lock L behind R, Step fwd on R
5,6	Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R
7&8	Step back on L, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L
	Rock Fwd Back, 1/2 Shuffle, Full Turn, 1/4 Pivot Step Across
9,10	Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L
11&12	Making 1/2 right shuffle fwd R,L,R
13,14	Step fwd LR while making a full turn right (walk fwd if you don't like turns)
15&16	Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right transferring wt to R, Step L across R
	&Across Side, Left Sailor Step, Right Sailor Step, 1/4 Coaster
&17,18	Step R beside L, Step L across R, Step R to right
19&20	Step L behind R, Step R to right, Step L to left
21&22	Step R behind L, Step L to left, Step R to right
23&24	Making 1/4 left step back on L, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L
	1/4 Pivot, Shuffle Fwd, Step Pivot 1/2, Paddle 1/4, Paddle 1/4
25,26	Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L
27&28	Shuffle fwd R,L,R
29,30	Ct. C. 1 I. D 1/2 : 1.4 C
&31	Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/2 right transferring wt to R Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right
&31 &31	Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right
& 31	Step Twd On E, TTVOC 1/4 Tight

	It is very clear in the musicand the dance won't make sense without these easy tags
