1& 2& 3&4	Side Rock/Replace, Tap Hitch, Behind Side Across, Rock/step R to right, Rock/replace wt sideways onto L Tap R toe to right, Hitch R Step R behind L, Step L to left, Step R across L
5&6 7&,8	Side Rock Across, 1/4 Back Lock Back Rock/step L to left, Rock/replace wt sideways onto R, Step L across R Making 1/4 left step back on R, Lock L across R, Step back on R Original sheet by
9&10 11&12	Coaster Step, Shuffle Fwd Step back on L, Step R beside L Step fwd on L Shuffle fwd R,L,R Jan Wyllie
13&14& 15&16	Heel & Touch & Heel & Touch Touch L heel fwd, Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Step back on R Touch L heel fwd, Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L
17&18& 19&20	Step Right Touch, Step Left Kick, Behind Side Across Step R to right, Touch L beside R, Step L to left, Kick R to right diagonal Step R behind L, Step L to left, Step R across L
21&22& 23&24	Step Left Touch, Step Right Kick, Behind Side Across Step L to left, Touch R beside L, Step R to right, Kick L to left diagonal Step L behind R, Step R to right, Step L across R
25&26 27&28	Side Together Back, 1/4 Side Together Fwd, Step R to right, Step L beside R, Step back on R Making 1/4 left step L to left, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L
29&30 31&32	Step Pivot 1/4 Step Fwd, Heel & Touch Step fwd on R, Pivot 1/4 left transferring wt to L, Step fwd on R Touch L heel fwd, Step L beside R, Touch R beside L

*There is a restart on wall 4 after count 16

*There is a restart on wall 8 after count 16...

and please stomp RL before starting dance again

FINISH The last wall of the dance starts facing 3 o'clock. Dance up to count 20 then step L to left and step R across L (becomes a cross shuffle)
